IN 2011, 558 FOUNDATIONS IN ARIZONA GRANTED \$264,141,287. IN COMPARISON TO 2009, THERE WAS A 16.2% INCREASE IN THE DOLLARS GRANTED AND A 4.9% INCREASE IN THE ASSETS OF FOUNDATIONS ACROSS THE STATE. THE AVERAGE GRANT SIZE IN 2011 WAS \$37,453.3


