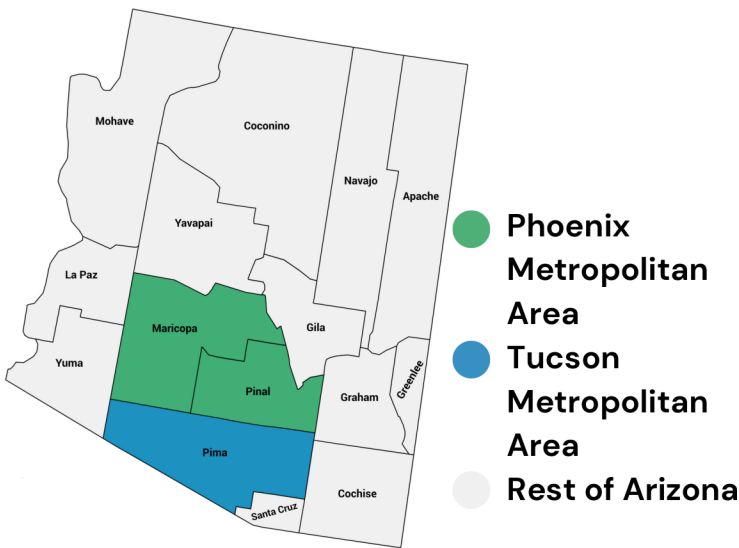


Economic Impact of Philanthropy

Arizona

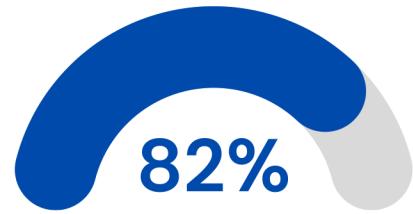

Recipient Behaviors

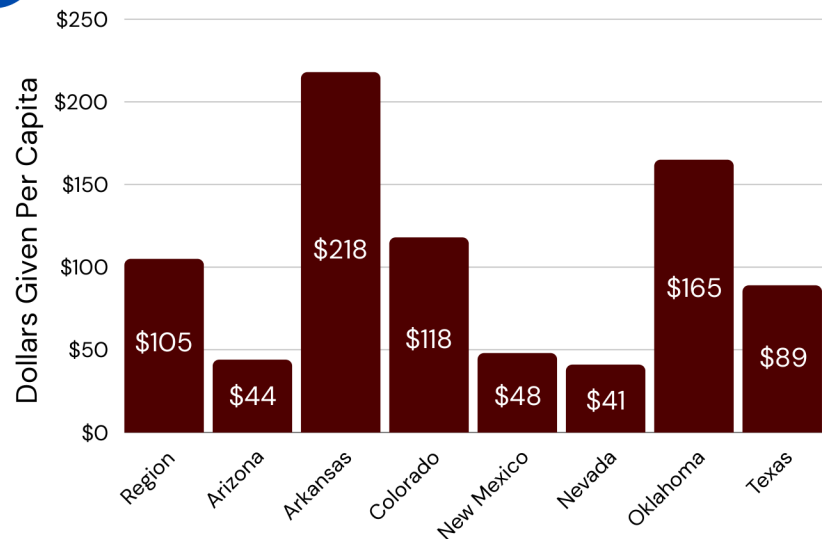
Grant-receiving organizations in Arizona invested



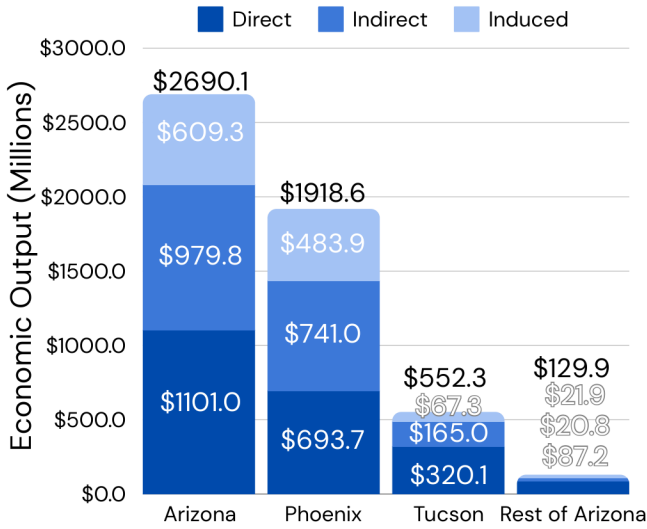
of their funds into program services.

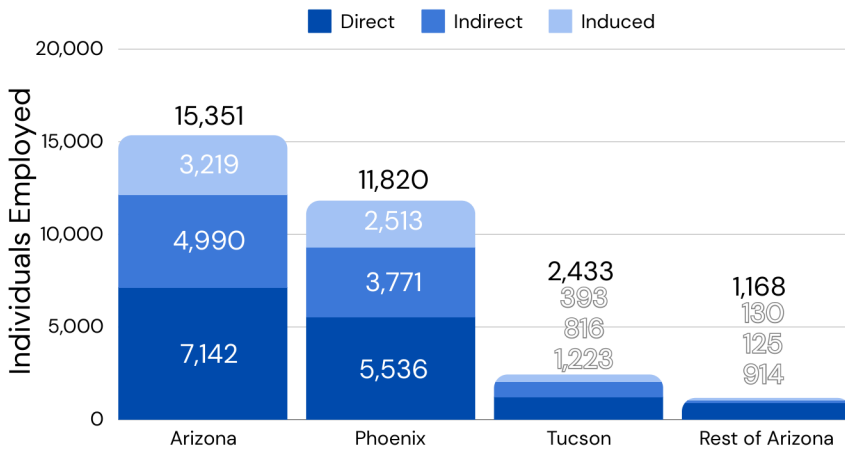
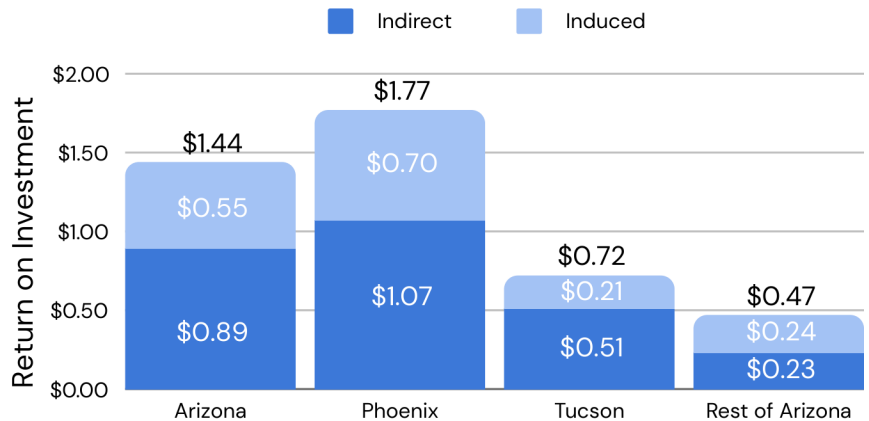
