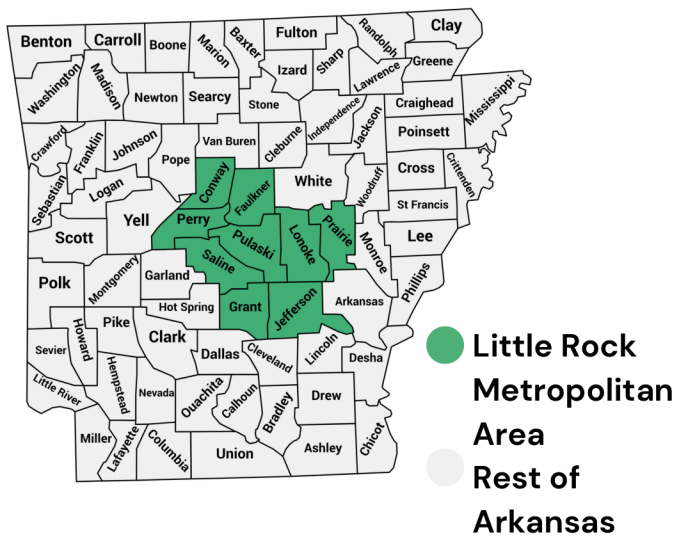


Economic Impact of Philanthropy

Arkansas

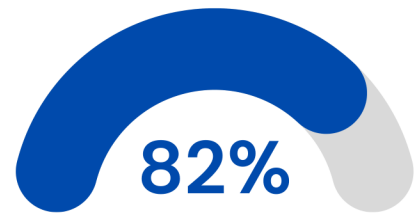

Recipient Behaviors

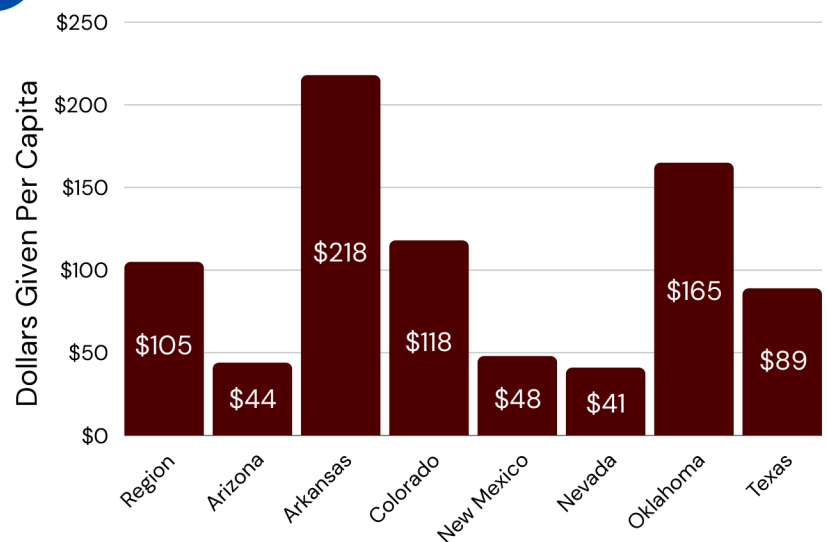
Grant-receiving organizations in Arkansas invested



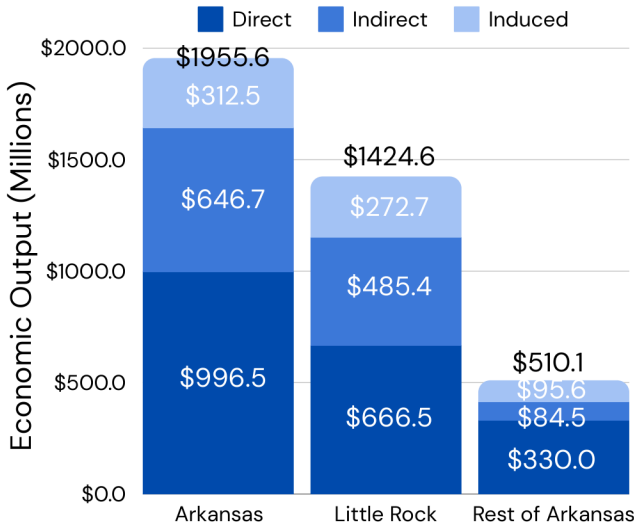
of their funds into program services.

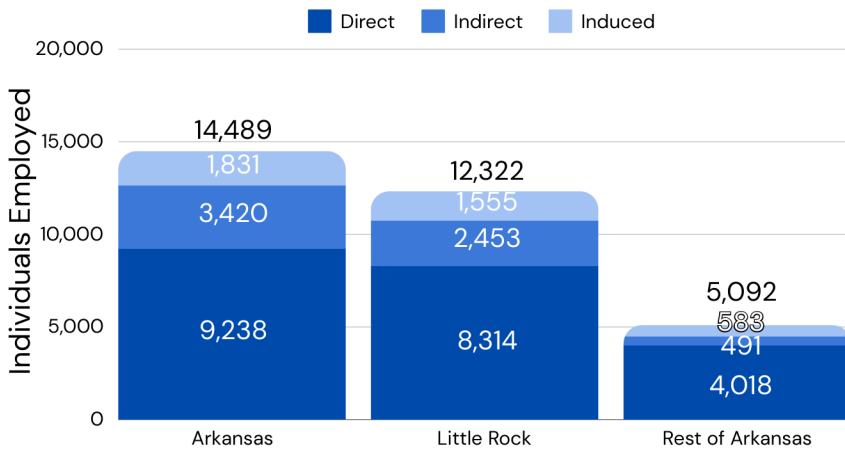
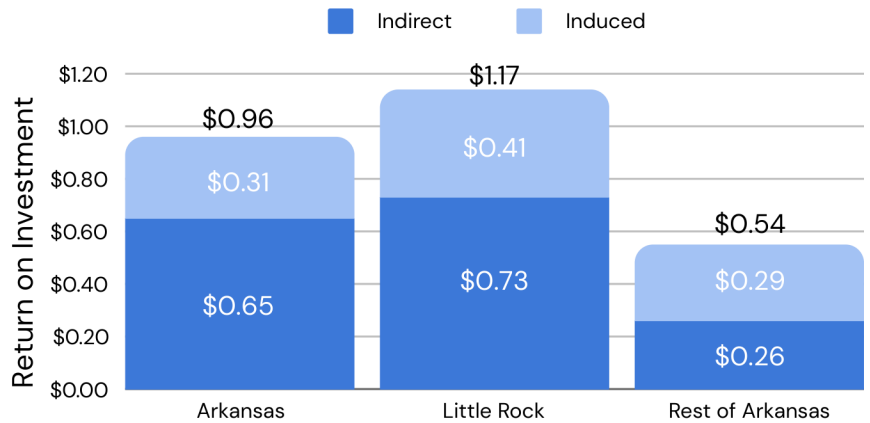
