Nevada

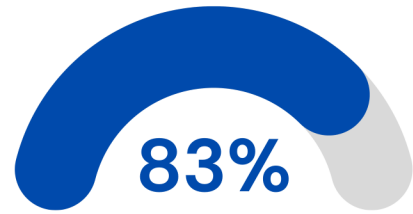

Recipient Behaviors

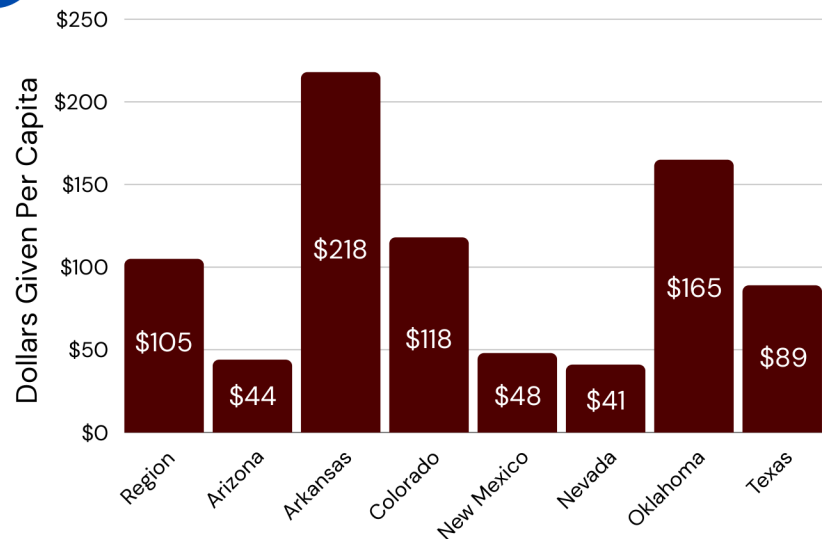
Grant-receiving organizations in Nevada invested



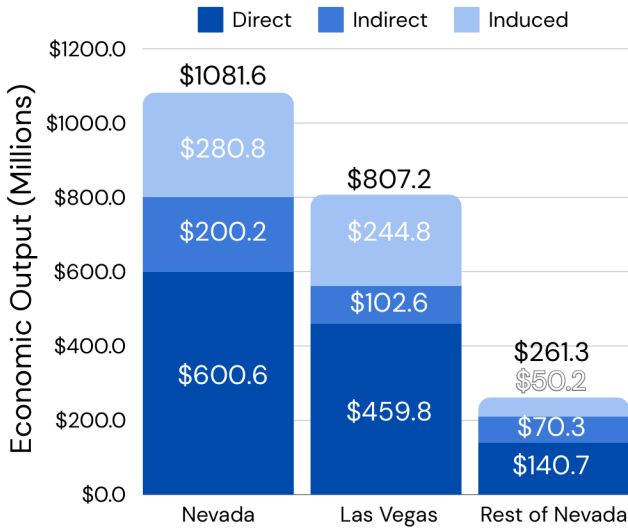

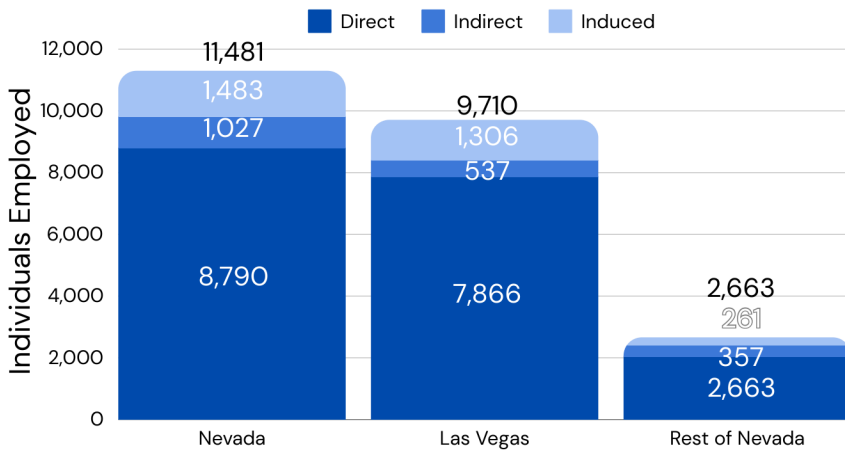
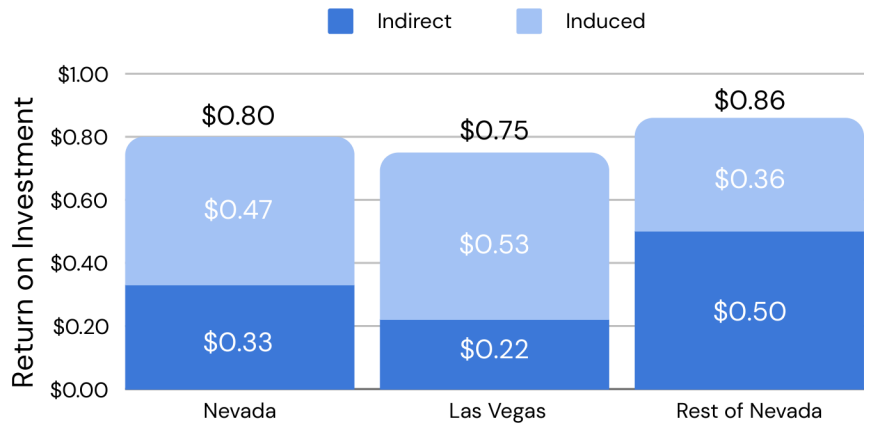
