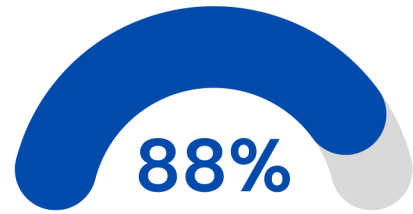

Recipient Behaviors



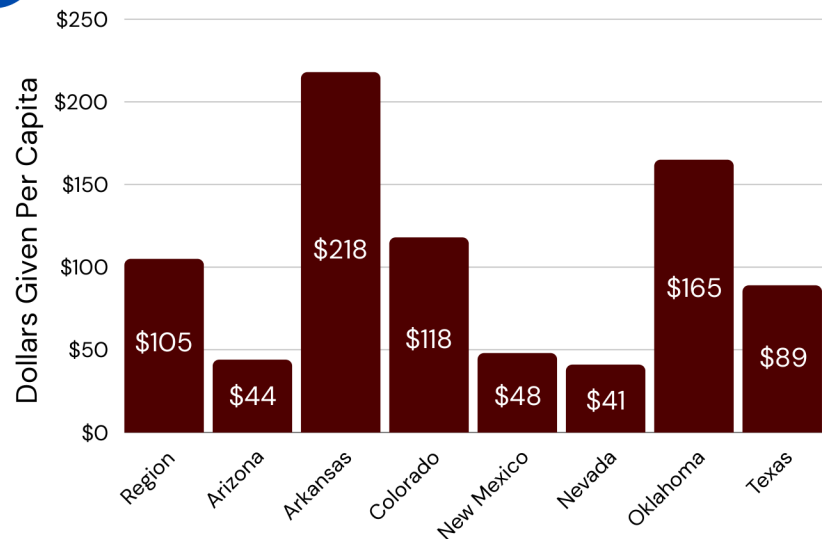
Grant-receiving organizations in Oklahoma invested



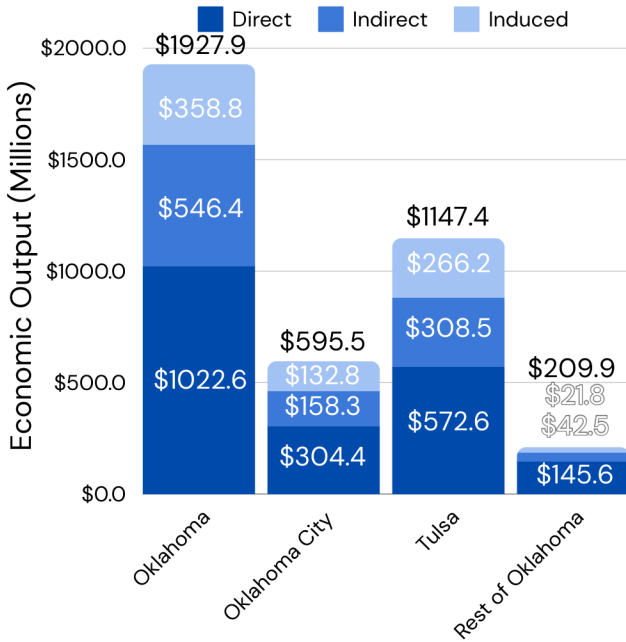

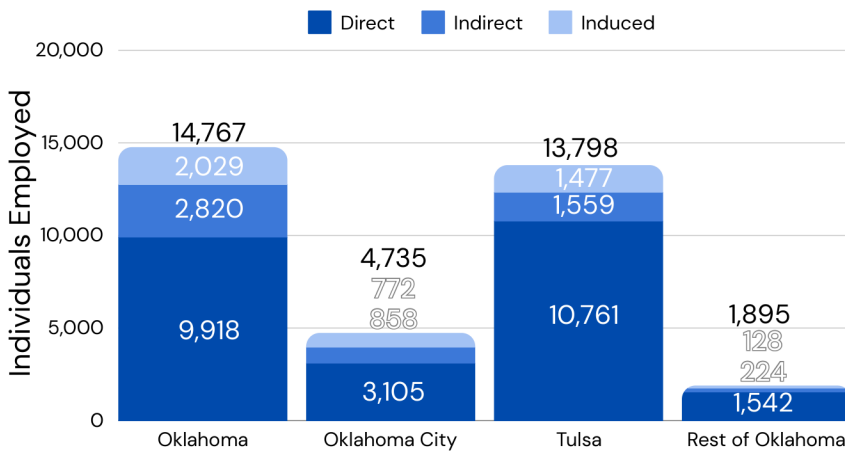
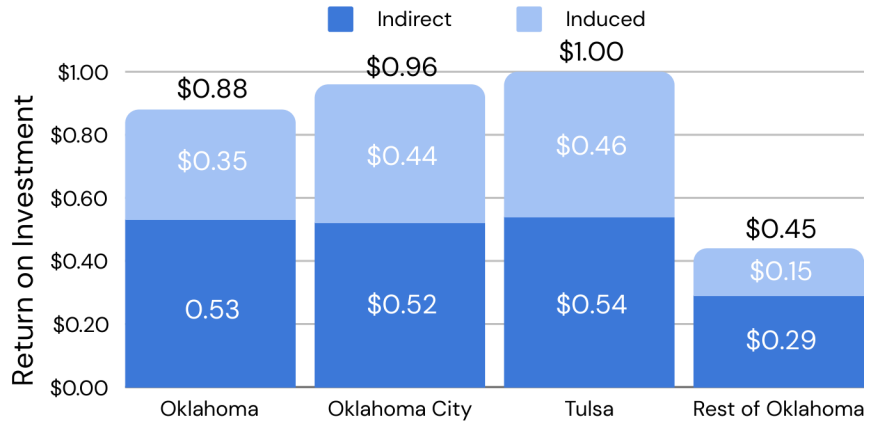
